Order No. 1822

"The Order on Security Provisions (amendment no. 65) (Judea and Samaria) (no. 1822), 2019

Under my authority as commander of the IDF forces in the region, and believing that the following is necessary for maintaining security and Public Safety in the region, I hereby decree:

Amendment to article 89

1.

In the Order Regarding Security Provisions (consolidated version) (Judea and Samaria) (no. 1651). 2009, in article 89 -

(1) In section (b), following "for the protection of the matter of", "a victim of an offense as defined in article section 186 of this order or the matter of" will be added.

(2) Following section (c), the following will be added:

(c1) During a hearing of the request for a hearing in camera, a military court is authorized, if the representative of the IDF forces in the region asks for it, to stray from the laws of evidence for reasons to be recorded, and to admit a piece of evidence also if a party to the hearing or their representative are not present, or without disclosing said evidence to the latter, if the court has been convinced that the disclosure of said evidence may harm the security of the region, public peace or public Safety, or reveal confidential working methods, and that not disclosing it is preferable to disclosing it for the purpose of doing Justice. A military court is authorized, prior to making a decision in accordance with this section, to review the evidence and receive explanations from the representative of the commander of the IDF forces in the region, or from the military prosecutor, also in the absence of other parties to the legal case.

(3) The Following will be added following section (e)

(f) In spite of what is stated in section 89(b), a military court will conduct its session in camera during the testimony of a witness whose identity is confidential in accordance with a confidentiality certificate issued in accordance with article 87, or by the instruction of any other law, however the court may, for reasons to be recorded, hear the matter, all of it or some of it, in public.

Amendment to article 138

2.

In article 138 of the Order -

(1) Section (a) will be followed by:

(a1) a military youth court will hear the case in camera, however it is authorized to allow a person or types of persons, including the victim of the offense, to be present at the time of the hearing, all of it or part of it.

(2) In section (b) the word "small" will be removed
